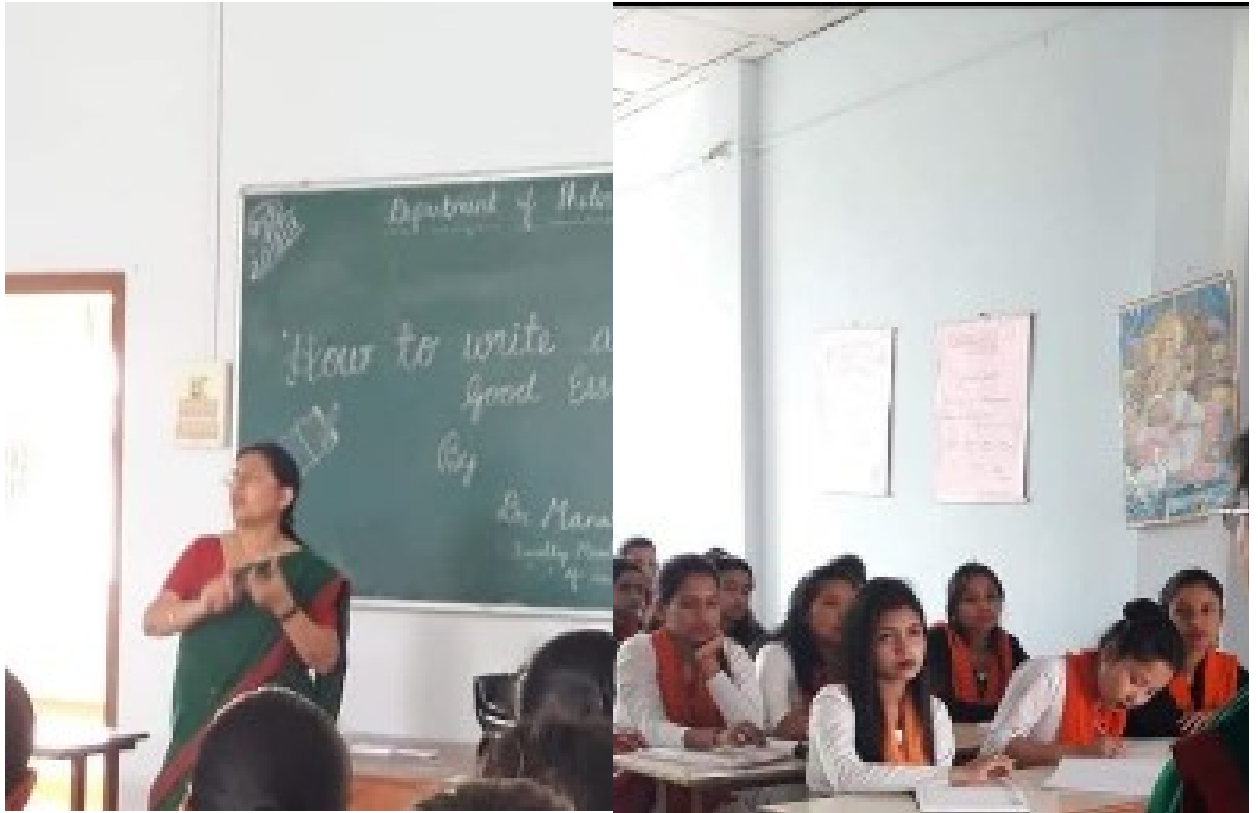

B. A talk cum interactive session was organized by Department of MDKG College on 27.8.19. on 'Marxism: An analysis from standpoint of Political Science.'

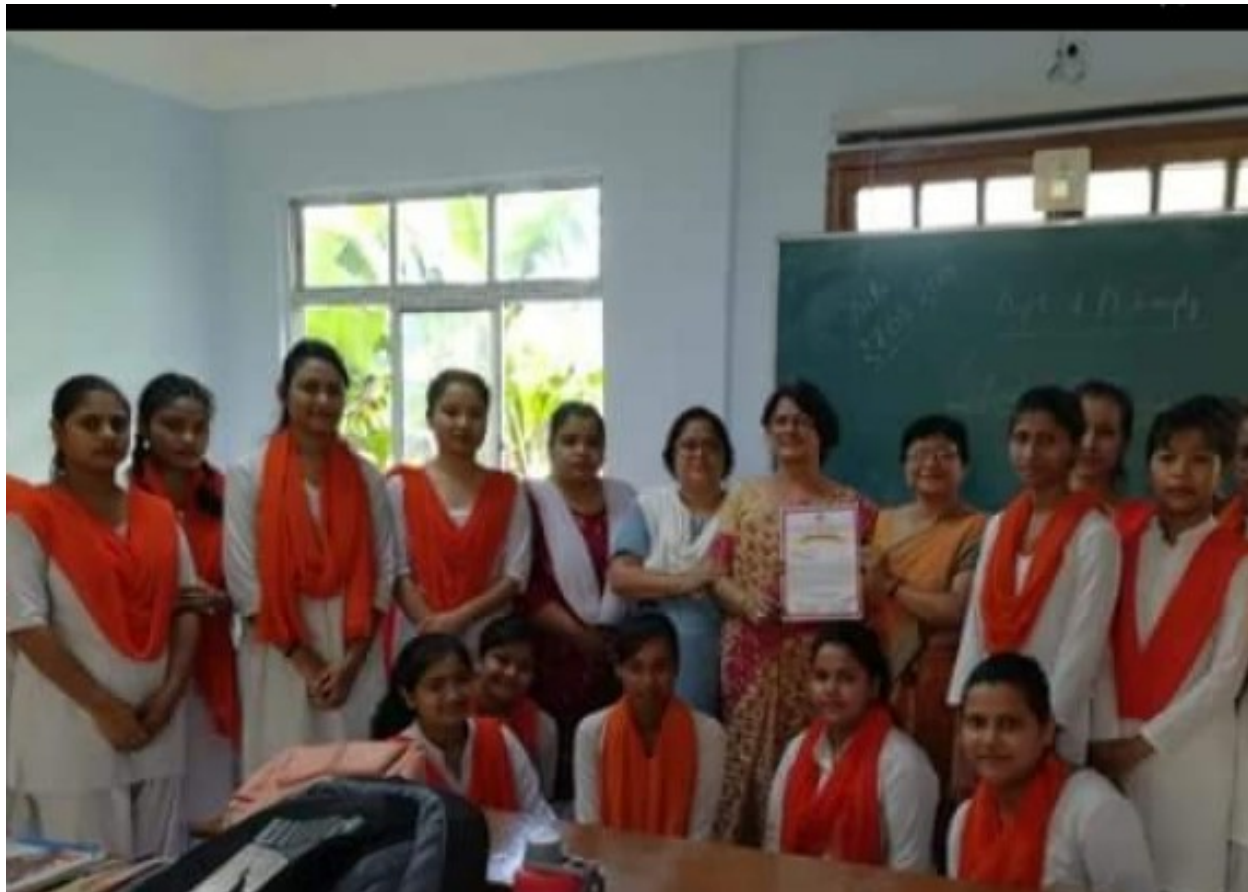

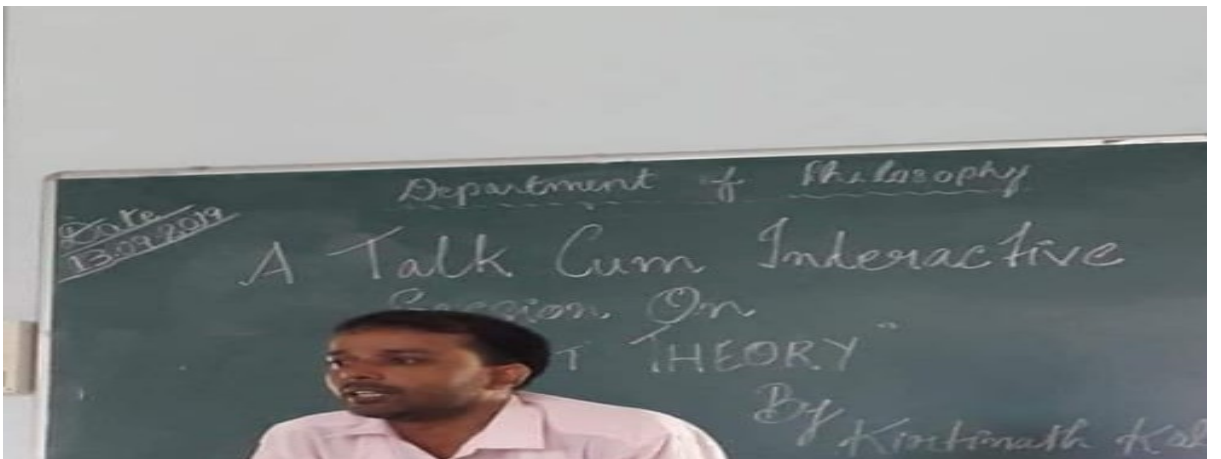
