

One Day Orientation Programme on CBCS

A one day orientation programme was organized by IQAC, MDKG College on 21st May, 2019. Dibrugarh University earlier decided to introduce the CBCS from the academic year 2018-19 which was later postponed to the academic year 2019-20. In light of the conflicting views regarding the implementation of CBCS as well as the various courses offered under CBCS. The resource person for this one day orientation programme was Prof. Jiten Hazarika from the department of Statistics of Dibrugarh University.

Prof. Hazarika first began by elucidating the necessity of introducing CBCS not only in the colleges affiliated to Dibrugarh University but also among various universities all over India. He said that a uniform syllabus among the various universities allowed a dual advantage to the students. Firstly it facilitated a similar course structure among the students and also paved the path for easy inter university transfer. At the same time, it also allowed the students to choose from an array of subjects which was not available earlier. The credit system also diminished the excessive importance on marks that was prevalent in the earlier system of examination. Prof. Hazarika emphasized that keeping in mind the limited infrastructural facilities and the scarcity of faculty, it will prove to be an uphill task. However, keeping in mind the sweeping changes in education in the global scenario, it is of utmost importance to keep abreast with the times. He, through various comparisons highlighted the means through which credit is calculated for the students and how they will be given thus SGPA or CGPA.

Prof. Hazarika also interacted with the faculty members present and took up various questions put to him regarding CBCS. He said that with regards the success of the CBCS time will only tell but there should be a positive vibe among all stakeholders, otherwise the success of CBCS is not guaranteed at all.
